Humboldt Community School District Parking Lot Student Handbook

Safety is always our first and #1 priority. The parking lot rules will be strictly enforced to ensure the safety of all staff, students, parents, and visitors.

All drivers should abide by Humboldt Community signs posted; drive with care and caution on the streets surrounding the school campus. **Utilize the appropriate entrances and exits.** Be mindful of pedestrians. Care should be taken to park in allowed areas only, and to be respectful to others and their property (i.e. avoid blocking off areas, littering, etc.).

Rules of the Parking lot:

1. Students must park in designated student parking areas; there are no areas that are designated for grade levels. Spots are by availability each day. Students are **NOT** to park in the staff parking lot north of the school.
2. Park in the spaces properly (no overlap of yellow lines, angled, or crooked.) Parking in non-parking areas such as grass, fire lanes, sidewalks or no-parking zones is not permitted. **You will be given one warning before consequences are given.**
3. Excessive speed, rapid acceleration or excessive rotation of tires (burn-outs) is not permitted. You may be ticketed for inappropriate behavior.
4. Passengers are not allowed to ride on the outside of the vehicle at any time the vehicle is running.
5. Parking in a handicapped space without a state issued handicap permit assigned to the driver is in violation and will be ticketed and/or towed.
6. All students using the parking lots must complete a parking agreement contract and register their vehicle(s).
7. Students caught being fraudulent may be towed or ticketed and may lose future privileges to park on campus.

To register a student vehicle:

Student driver must enter the following information with this information in order to utilize the parking lot:

1. Valid Driver's License#/ School Permit
2. Make/Model
3. Year
4. Color
5. License plate #

Violations of these rules will result in consequences:

- 1 st Violation: Building Warning
- 2 nd Violation: School Parking Ticket Issued; possible suspension of parking privileges
- 3 rd Violation: City of Humboldt Ticket Issued; possible suspension of parking privileges
- 4 th Violation: Building may request that vehicle be towed at owner's expense; possible suspension of parking privileges

***** Administration and/or Humboldt PD has the right to give a higher consequence depending on the severity of the infraction. The school retains the right to revoke parking privileges at any offense considering the circumstances.**
