## Humboldt Community School District Board of Education Regular Meeting February 21, 2022

The Humboldt School Board of Education held a regular meeting at 5:00pm on Monday, February 22, 2022 at Administration Office Board Room. Roll Call-Satern-Aye, Clark-Aye Mertz-Aye, Davis-Aye.
